To Whom It May Concern:

Enclosed you will find an application form for a scholarship to be given by the Tuscarawas County Pork Producers for the 2025-2026 academic year. The scholarship amounts are variable depending on the student interests, major, and academic aptitude(minimum of \$750). We encourage any student who plans to pursue a career in agriculture or an agriculture-related field to apply, although any student may apply.

Applicants must be a resident of Tuscarawas County or a Tuscarawas County Pork Producers family member, **a 4-H or FFA member**, a current high school senior or enrolled college student up to the age of 25 and be in good academic standing where enrolled. We will also consider financial need, leadership and motivational goals. The scholarship is available to any 4-H or FFA member or community member entering or attending a two or four- year undergraduate program, **but first preference is given to Market Hog exhibitors and those entering an agriculture career field.**

Applications are due on or before March 14, 2025. Please copy this application and encourage students to apply.

Tuscarawas County Pork Producers Scholarship Requirements:

1. A resident of Tuscarawas County or a Tuscarawas County Pork Producers family member.
2. Current high school senior or enrolled college student up to the age of 25 **pursuing an undergraduate degree**.
3. Students pursuing a career in agriculture or agriculture-related fields of study will receive priority consideration and students exhibiting Market Hog Projects.
4. Must be in good academic standing where currently enrolled (2.0 OR HIGHER).
5. Provide a copy of academic transcripts
 - a. Current high school senior: official high school transcript **and** unofficial college transcript for post-secondary students.
 - b. College freshman: include official high school transcript and unofficial college transcript.
 - c. College sophomore or higher: include unofficial college transcript.
6. **High School Seniors:** Write an essay of no less than 250 words and no more than 650 words that talks about yourself, why you chose your educational degree/goal, career path, life goals and how 4-H has had an impact on you.
College students (first or second year): Discuss how your educational and career goals have changed over the past year, what clubs and organizations you are involved with, and how 4-H helped you develop a good work ethic.
College students (third or fourth year): Now that you are nearing the completion of your degree, where do you see yourself in the next chapter of your life (Where do you want to live, work, what organizations do you see yourself involved in, etc.).
7. Provide a current picture of yourself (no larger than 4 x 6).
8. Provide two CURRENT character recommendation letters. One **MUST** be from the school or college that you are attending and printed on school letterhead. This can be from an instructor, advisor, resident assistant, etc. They must be dated this year.
9. **ALL parts of the application must be filled-in completely and all requested items included in order to be considered (Send a picture, no larger than a 4 X 6).**
10. Applications must be **received** on or before March 14, 2025.
