Talk with your child about which string instrument they like the most, and join us in the next step in enrolling in the orchestra program. Participation in the orchestra program fosters many positive opportunities in discovery and cognitive development for your child including: building one's self-esteem, acquisition of fine motor and thinking skills, team building, making new friends, performance experience, and of course having fun learning music!



**Stop in for our brief fitting and sign-up night on Monday, August 24th between 4:00-7:00 PM in the PSI Cafeteria to ensure that your child is signed up for orchestra!**

At the meeting, you will get to meet with your orchestra teacher, try the instruments, choose your favorite instrument, be measured for the correct size, and meet with a Loft Violin Shop representative to rent your very own instrument! (If you already have your own string instrument, please bring it in. The Loft Violin Shop will be available for inspections of your personally owned instrument). All rented instruments and supplies will be delivered to the school on the first day of class. It's that easy!

If you cannot make it to the fitting night, no worries, **you can do everything online!**

Here are the three main things you should know if you want to be in the orchestra:

- 1) You need to inform me that you want to be in the Orchestra class (fill out a Google Form).**
- 2) You need to have a PROPERLY SIZED instrument (rented or purchased).**
- 3) You need to order a book "Essential Elements Book 1 (for your instrument).**
