## **About ParentSquare**

ParentSquare is a robust communication platform that offers a whole host of tools which allows the district, school administrators, and teachers to more effectively communicate with families and students. Some features include:

- · Mass Notifications and Urgent Alerts with two-way communication
- · Mobile Application for administrators and parents
- · Attendance Notifications
- · Teacher and Classroom Communication
- · Direct Messaging and Chat with Two-Way Translation
- · Social and Website Share
- · Forms and Permission Slips
- · Parent Teacher Conference Sign-Ups
- · Calendar and RSVP
- · Volunteering and Supply Sign-Up
- · StudentSquare (similar to Remind with added Security)
- · And More

That's a lot to roll out all at once! We will be taking it slow and start with the mass communication, mobile app, and classroom communication.

### **Timing of Roll-Out**

In order to launch ParentSquare effectively, we have built a training launch schedule. It's important that all sites attend a ParentSquare training, and that sites identify a school-level champion. The ParentSquare system is pretty intuitive.
