Topic and Assessment outline (in teaching order)

Topic	Content	Assessment Type	Teaching Time
Performance	Students learn skills on a selected instrument throughout the year. These include lessons with an itinerant teacher once a week during music class. Sometimes students are rotated out of other classes if there is not enough space during class time.	Performance	All year
Theory	Students continue building on their theoretical knowledge from Year 9. Topics include: Naming Notes, Note Values, Time Signatures, Key Signatures, Scales, Intervals, Chords and Terms and Signs	In-class tests & online	All year
Composition	Students use their knowledge of music theory and the elements of music to create their own original compositions using a Digital Audio Workstation (DAW) and music notation software.	Recording	Term 2 & 4

Drumline	Students learn to read rhythmic notation and play as part of a drumline ensemble.	Performance	Term 1
MIDI Sequencing	Students use the features and functions of a digital audio workstation (DAW) to convert a piece of sheet music into an electronic soundscape.	Recording	Term 3
