Article 3 – Teacher's Collective Bargaining Agreement

To see if the school district will vote to approve the cost items included in the collective bargaining agreement reached between the School Board and the Waterville Valley Educators Association which calls for the following increases in salaries and benefits at the current staffing level:

Fiscal Tear Estimated Increase

2025-2026 \$40,246 2026-2027 \$27,106 2027-2028 \$22,791

And further to raise and appropriate Forty Thousand Two Hundred Forty-Six dollars (\$40,246) for the current fiscal year, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increase in salaries and benefits required by the new agreement over those that would be paid at current staffing levels.
