The document below illustrates the Columbian Exchange.

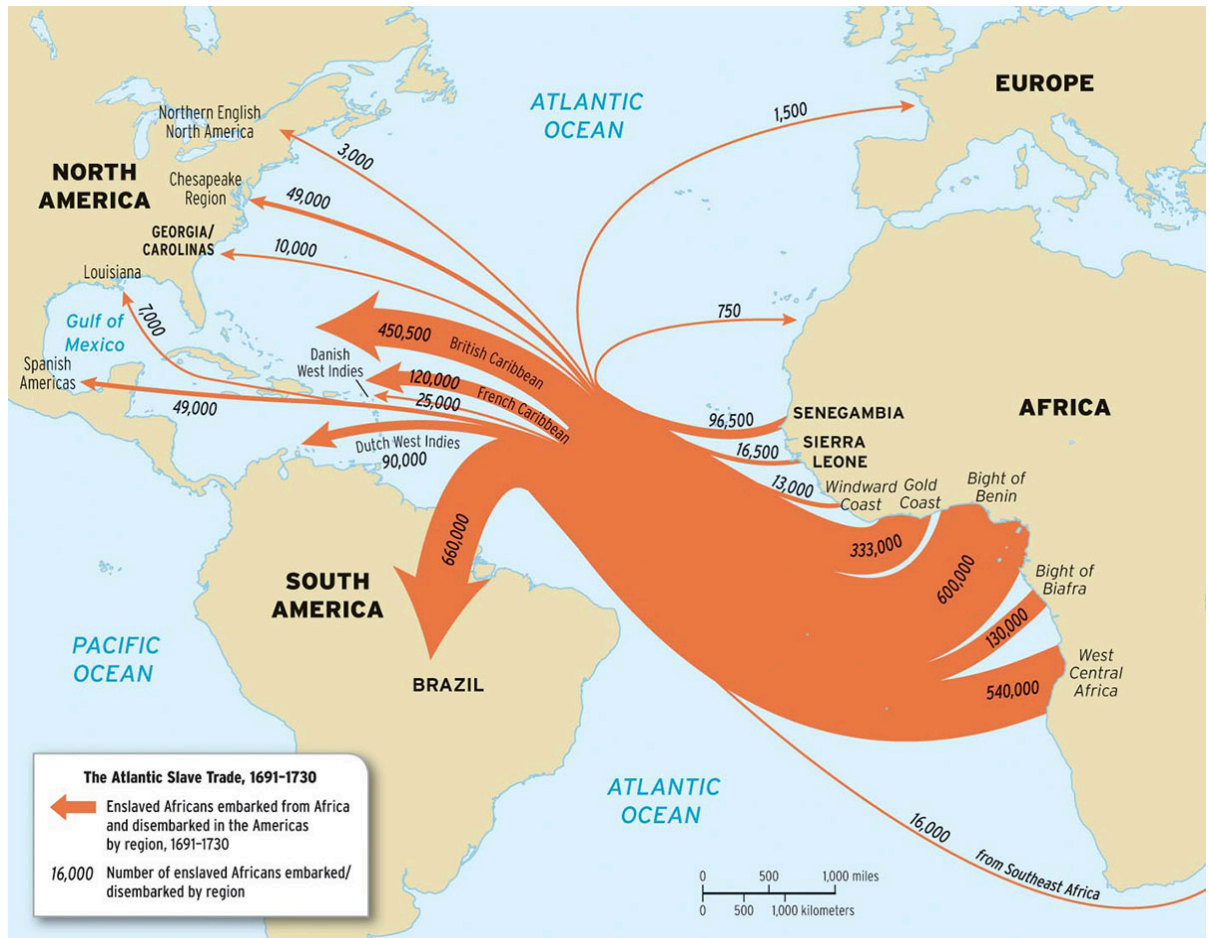

The document below shows the Atlantic Slave Trade.



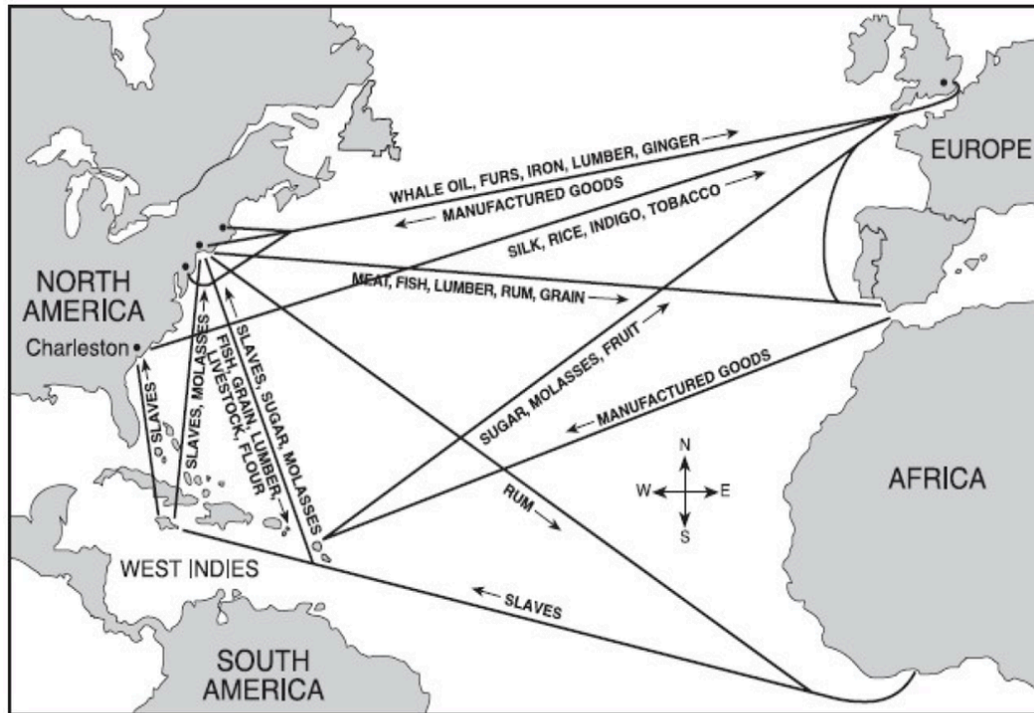
