3. Administr Update –		 Vaccination clinics: Two clinics are coming up for children ages 5-11 and the first one will take place in our school on March 8th. An information form with waiver sent home with students and only those with a completed waiver will participate. The second clinic will take place during March Break, on the 15th. Both clinics are run by Durham Region Public Health. February is Black History and Kindness Month: Ryan gave those present at the meeting a virtual tour of what has been happening this month within the school. Pink Shirt Day: Many wore pink shirts to school and conversations took place throughout the classes. Grade 8 Graduation Photos: completed X Movement: The school has purchased a few packages for staff and families. On March 25th students will participate in this school experience during class time. Elementary Report Cards: All reports have been sent home via email and can be accessed through School Messenger. Leonardo Leaders: The students are spearheading a lots of spirit days in the coming month. School Improvement Team: A survey was sent to students to understand the various ways in which they identify themselves and to address this in school. Masks: Please continue to send multiple masks to school with students. School Communication: All are encouraged to continue to follow the school's social media accounts as information is posted on a regular basis. Inclement weather (indoor recess): The school has inclement weather guidelines it follows sent from DDSB, in regard to when the weather is too hot or cold and when students are to stay inside. Currently the field has become a sheet of ice, and from a safety perspective students can not be on the field as that could lead to serious injuries. The pavement space is not sufficient for the number of students in the school as cohorts cannot be maintained. Friday Cookie Days: The school will also be selling popcorn to the students on the same day. T

	 Intermural and Extra-curriculars: Activities are starting up again; there will be Intermediate boys and girls' basketball teams. Options will be available for the junior students, but information is yet to come from the Phys ed department. March Break: will take place March 14-18th, 2022. EQAO: Testing will occur this year and it will be all digital. Primary EQAO takes place May 30th – June 2nd, June 3rd will be the make up day. Junior EQAO takes place June 6th-June 9th and June 10th will be the make up day. Disconnecting from work: A new policy introduced by the Ministry that is being filtered down into the school boards. Direction has been given providing guidelines as to when staff is required to answer communication received via email, phone, etc. We have been advised that responses can halt between on weekdays from 6:00 PM-7:00 AM, and all day on weekends and statutory holidays.

5. Learning Commons - Kathryn	 Kathryn shared photos with those present describing the various activities taking place in the Learning Commons. A TV was installed outside of the Learning Commons and is being used to share students' work. In February students shared kindness messages with each other. Forest of Reading continues, and students are using Osmos as a means to access the books. STEM continues to take place within the library. Students have been coding using robotic mice.
6. SCC Constitution - Emilete	- The committee has yet to meet. Will provide an update at the next SCC meeting.
7. PRO Grant - Emilete	 The application form was completed and sent in, it has been approved and meetings will be ongoing to organize the event. Next meeting on March 8th, 2022.
8. SCC Fundraiser - Emilete	 Ideas / suggestions are needed. At the moment the fundraiser must be virtual for the time being. Suggestions: Little Caesar's Pizza kits; a good idea but may have to wait to try this due to DDSB Covid guidelines. Plantables: Suggested by Kim; the school would register with a company and receive 10% back from the sales. Parents/guardians and families can purchase pre-grown plants which will be delivered to our homes. Kathryn supported the idea and has participated in a similar campaign with her children's school. Those present voiced full support for this fundraiser, please share the word with fellow parents/guardians once it is put into place. Emilete will set it up this fundraiser by the SCC meeting in April.
9. Questions & Answer – Ryan & Emilete	 Grade 8 Graduation and trip: At this time the school is planning a virtual graduation. A memo was sent from DDSB regarding field trips, and it is clear there will be no trips for this purpose. da Vinci 10th Anniversary: The school is hoping to do something and there has been discussion within the staff. DDSB does not recognize 10th anniversaries so this will be a school-led initiative.
