March to the Scaffold: Worksheet Assignment

Learning Goal(s):

I can...

- Identify where the original A theme (primary theme) is heard
- Identify where the original B theme (secondary theme) is heard
- Identify at least 2 ways in which the B theme is distinctly different from the A theme.
- Extra credit: Identify where variations of the A theme begin.

Process:

- Using <u>THIS RECORDING</u>, listen to the whole piece to get an idea of what it sounds like (~4 minutes).
 - Listen carefully for melodies that are repeated.
- Listen to the piece again.
 - Pause where you believe the A theme (first recognizable theme) is played for the first time.
 - Write down the time stamp where you paused
 - Circle the corresponding measure number in your music
 - Pause where you believe the B theme (second recognizable theme) is played for the first time.
 - Write down the time stamp where you paused
 - Circle the corresponding measure number in your music
- Extra credit: Listen to the piece again, carefully. Try to identify where you hear the A theme throughout the piece. Hint: It comes back many times, but each time it comes back, it's changed a little bit.
- When you're done listening to the piece, go to <u>THIS LINK</u> and type in your answers. Remember to CLICK SUBMIT to send the form!
