Introduction to Set Free Monterey Bay (SFMB)

Set Free Monterey Bay is a Christian organization established to assist adult women (ages 18 and over) sex trafficking survivors to find healing in a Christ-centered, restoration home and to educate the Monterey Bay community about human trafficking. Our goals are to restore lives, educate students and partner with the community in order to fight human trafficking and create new futures in our area. We seek to empower churches, schools, businesses and individuals to bring the love of Jesus to those caught in human trafficking.

Vision & Mission of the SFMB Ambassador Program

The Ambassador Program is a group of individuals who support the vision and mission of Set Free Monterey Bay by engaging in the program as advocates, volunteers and committee members. As an SFMB Ambassador, you have the opportunity to represent the faith-filled work of the organization and use your gifts and abilities to bring hope to those oppressed by the human trafficking industry. The responsibilities of an Ambassador are:

- 1. **Ambassadors**: Ambassadors represent Set Free Monterey Bay as an organization, sharing about the work we do with family, friends, and other connections available.
- 2. **Advocate**: Ambassadors are encouraged to educate themselves on the issues of human trafficking, preparing to help connect survivors to resources that can help meet their immediate and/or long-term needs should that opportunity arise.
- 3. **Volunteer**: Ambassadors are invited to be a part of the Volunteer Team, attending any training or meetings, as well as participating in any outreach or events organized by the Program Director.
- 4. **Committee Member/Special Projects**: Ambassadors are approved to be added to one of the service committees or special projects, supervised by an SFMB Board Member. The list of current committees is available on the application form.
