Field Study B: Initial Student Teaching (Pass FAST SVP)

- 3. Credential coursework must be taken for a letter grade, except those courses that are only offered for Credit/No credit.
- 4. A **3.00 overall GPA** must be maintained throughout the credential coursework.
- 5. No grade lower than a 'C'. Candidates who earn a 'D', 'F', 'W', 'WU' or 'NC' grade in any professional coursework must request a special consideration to retake those courses. This will result in additional semesters to complete the program.
- 6. To enroll in EHD 170, the student must:
 - a. Complete all Phase 1 coursework with a 3.00 GPA.
 - b. Meet subject matter competency
 - c. Possess a valid Certificate of Clearance and TB Risk Assessment.
- 7. Professional Study Plans are subject to change. Notifications to students will be made if necessary.

ADDITIONAL NOTES

Preliminary Multiple Subject credential application eligibility

- Complete all coursework with a 3.0 GPA [no D or F grades], within ten (10) years prior to applying for your preliminary credential.
- Pass the Fresno Assessment of Student Teachers (FAST)
