Where is the SNaHP Summit being held?

The SNaHP Summit will be held in-person in at Roosevelt University, 430 S. MIchigan Avenue, Chicago

What are the dates for the SNaHP Summit?

The SNaHP Summit will be held on Friday afternoon (noon to 6 pm), November 15th in Chicago.

PNHP's Annual Meeting will be held all day on Saturday, November 16th at Venue SIX10, 610 S. Michigan Avenue, Chicago.

Who can apply for a Nicholas Skala Student Activist Scholarship?

Eligibility is open to SNaHP members, residents, fellows, and students over the age of 18 years old who want to get active in the fight for Medicare for All.

Do I have to attend the entire weekend?

We prefer that you attend the entire SNaHP Summit on November 15 and PNHP Annual Meeting on November 16th. We will be prioritizing SNaHP members who are able to commit to being there for the entire Summit and PNHP Annual meeting.

What can I expect to learn?

Organizing/Leadership Skills: SNaHP members will learn to build powerful SNaHP chapters to win significant long-term progressive health justice changes: through one-on-ones, effective meetings, creating a team, campaign planning, the value of direct action, and clearly defined roles.

Community and Relationships: Join a national network of SNaHP members working together to build power and win a national single-payer program.

How will I get there?

You will need to arrange your travel to the Summit, but scholarship awards account for partial travel expenses.

Do I have to register for the conference?

Yes, All applicants must <u>REGISTER HERE</u> for the Annual Meeting at a special 75% discounted rate before they can receive an award from PNHP. Use the code **"INTRAINING"** to receive your student discount.

What does the scholarship cover?

Scholarship Funding will help cover travel expenses, housing, and registration during the summit: Airfare (80% of economy airfare, up to \$300), Auto Travel (gas and parking reimbursement with receipts), and Housing (\$200 stipend). Scholarship recipients will be responsible for coordinating their accommodations for the summit and annual meeting. Hostel, VRBO, and hotel spaces will fill up quickly. We encourage you to make your reservations early.

We strongly recommend exploring whether your academic institution might be able to provide additional financial support.
