#### **Definitions**

#### **Thurston Reports**

- Consists of 5 reports that are part of the AAP and scored by National & Regional Officers
- The 5 reports are the Chapter Publication, Scholarship Report, Leadership Report, Brotherhood Report, and Professional & Service Projects Report.

#### Thurston Cup (Also called Emory W. Thurston Grand President's Award)

- Trophy awarded to the highest-performing chapter in the country based on their scores on the 5 Thurston Reports.
- The winning chapter also receives the Ron Corey Excellence Scholarship (\$2,000).

#### **Grand Vice President for Student Affairs (GVPSA)**

- Oversees the AAP and promotes participation in the program
- Oversees Regional Correspondents to help chapters address areas for growth
- Serves as the "student voice" at the national level

#### **Regional Correspondent**

- Assists the region's chapters, particularly the Worthy Correspondents, with AAP completion
- Helps chapters identify areas for growth and come up with plans for improvement
- Serves as the "student voice" at the regional level

#### **Achievement Award Program (AAP) Administrator**

- National Office staff member who administers and manages the AAP & Thurston submissions and scoring process
- Currently Michelle Walkup (<u>aap@phideltachi.org</u>)

#### **Worthy Correspondent**

- Coordinates correspondence to and from other entities (other chapters, Grand Officers, and Regional Officers) on behalf of the chapter
- Leads the chapter in an understanding of the AAP and coordinate timely submission of all reports and associated items to the National Office
- Maintains regular communication with the Regional Correspondent
