

Title(Abstract Template for the 2nd International Conference on English Language Education (Times New Roman 16, bold, centered)

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Abstracts must be in English and should report new previously unpublished work and not considered for other publication. The total length is limited to **250 words** (all types of contributions - plenary, invited, contributed oral lectures as well as for posters). Please follow the requested format of the abstract template. The abstracts that will not confirm the format must be rejected. It is required to submit the abstract in electronic form via conference website ('abstract submission' link). The content of the abstract is the aim of the research, method, findings and implication. The submitted abstract must be a Microsoft Office Word file (*.doc, *.docx).

Deadline for abstract submission is April 30, 2020.
