 Learn signs related to Outside the House.

Success Criteria

I can

- Recognise and correctly sign the Auslan signs for Outside the House.
- Combine signs colour and item, e.g. blue hose.
- Match words and sign pictures in a Concentration Game.

Time	Teacher	Resources
5 mins	Set up the video to watch. Students seated on the floor.	
5 mins	Introduction: Introduce the topic - Outside the House We learnt signs for Around the House (Inside) last year in Term 2. Today we will learn signs for things outside the house. You will have many of these items at home, outside your house or where you live. Have fun learning the new signs.	Provided above
	 (Start of Lesson) Read and discuss the Learning Intention and Success Criteria. Check for understanding, clarifying vocabulary as necessary. 	
10 mins	Explicit Teaching: Watch the video	#B Lesson 5 video
	Use teacher discretion to decide if the class needs to watch any part of the video a second time. Signs taught: Backyard, grass, fence, gate, BBQ shed, letterbox, bucket, hose, garage, Lawn mower, garden, trees.	
5 mins	Explanation of Activity:	
	 Practise all taught signs together as a group with the teacher. Combine colours with signs, e.g. red bucket, blue hose. Concentration Game - Outside the House signs and word, match 	Concentration Game words
	 House signs and word - match. The class divides into small groups of 3 (or 4) at the tables. The sign and word cards are placed in 2 separate groups, face downwards on the table and mixed. Each student has a turn to select a card from the word group and the sign picture group attempting to match the two. 	and picture sheets below.

	 As the student turns the card they fingerspell the word card and sign the sign picture card. When they get a match they keep the 2 cards. So the game is played in typical Concentration Game style but with fingerspelling and signing included. 	
15 mins	Activity:	
	 Practise all taught signs together as a group with the teacher. Combine colours with signs, e.g. red bucket, blue hose. 	
	Outside the House Concentration Game	
5 mins	Reflection with Students: (Select from the following)	
	 Was it easy learning the new signs from Outside the House? Do you have some of these things at your house or where you live? When you go home perhaps you could take a family member outside and teach them the signs. Another good way of improving your Auslan is to combine the item and the colour (as in the video), e.g. red bucket, blue hose, brown fence. Practise this at home with your things. Do you use any of these things at home when helping your family? Share with the class.
