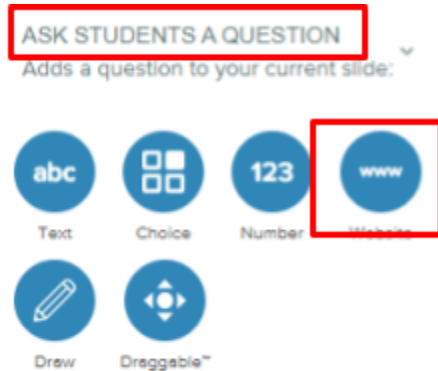


Embed Edpuzzle and Youtube video into Pear Deck

Edpuzzle

1. Get Embed Code from Edpuzzle:
 - A. On Edpuzzle open the assignment.
 - B. Once assignment is opened, click the 3 dots (...) and click Share assignment.
 - C. Copy the Embed code.
2. Paste the embed code into a Pear Deck Website Slide:
 - A. Open your Google Slides presentation and open the Pear Deck Add-On (if it is not already opened)
 - B. In the Pear Deck panel under "Ask Students a Question" click Website.



- C. Paste in the Embed code.
- D. Edpuzzle shows us the whole embed code. But for a Pear Deck Website slide, we need only the URL between the quotes (not the frame references surrounding it). The part of the URL we want to paste into the website preview window is highlighted in blue below:

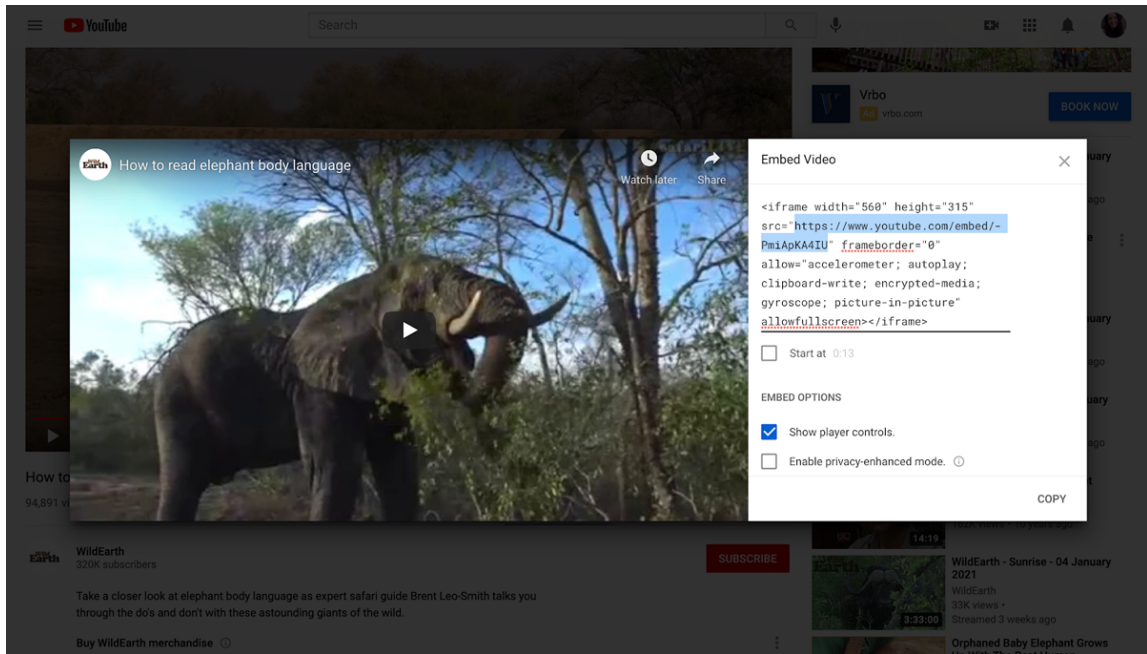

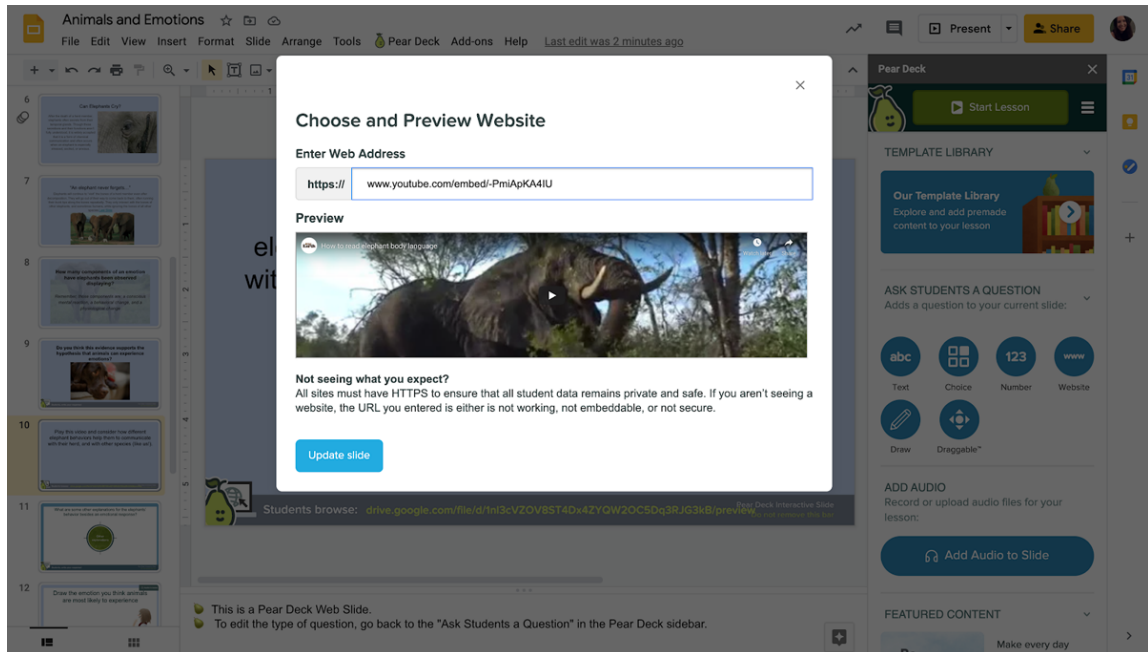

1. Get the Youtube video embed URL:
 - A. Open the video on YouTube.

- B. Select Share.
- C. Select Embed.
- D. Copy the URL found between the frame references, as highlighted below:



- 2. Paste the embed URL into a Pear Deck Website Slide:
 - A. Open your Google Slides presentation.
 - B. Open the Pear Deck Sidebar. Scroll down to Ask students a question and select Website.
 - C. In the Preview window, paste the embed URL from the YouTube video. When it has been properly embedded, the video appears in the Preview window.



- When you **present your Session** with Pear Deck, students will be able to see the body of the slide and play the video simultaneously:
