



Nucor Educational Initiative: Nucor Scholars Licensure Testing Reimbursement

Each year, sixteen Nucor scholarships will be given to teachers in the Nucor Scholars Licensure Testing Reimbursement Program. These Nucor Scholars will be reimbursed for testing fees associated with licensure exams leading to the attainment of a Continuing Professional License. Teachers may receive no more than \$250 per school year, and sixteen reimbursements will be awarded annually. Applications will be accepted year-round. Teachers who receive reimbursement while pursuing licensure must commit to teaching in Hertford County Public Schools for one full school year per calendar year after obtaining full certification, or they will be required to repay funds received.

The procedures are as follows:

- Information will be presented to teachers, and applications for the Nucor Scholars Licensure Testing Reimbursement will be distributed no later than September 1st of each school year.
- The deadline for teachers to submit applications for the Nucor Scholars Licensure Testing Reimbursement is the first day of each month.
- Applications are to be submitted to the Human Resource Services Department of Hertford County Public Schools.
- This award is given on a first-come, first-served basis.

Nucor Scholars must:

- Be registered for a required licensure exam.
- Submit documentation of registration, payment, and scores to the HCPS Human Resource Department.
- Sign a legal agreement stating that they will remain in Hertford County Public Schools for a minimum of 1 school year at the completion of their teacher certification.
