

GREAT WORLD SERIES(addition to Zak's work)

1904—York Yellowjackets vs. York WhiteRoses in first league World Series.

Jackets win first 2 games, Roses win next 2. Game 5 goes down to the wire with the Jackets winning 2-1 on doubles by “Chug” Stahl and Harry Lumley.

1905—Yellowjackets repeat in another 5-game series vs. Cy Young/Christy Mathewson and the Bombers. Game 5 Jackets are down 5-1 and storm back to win 6-5. Mike Grady hits 2 triples and a double in the comeback.

1906—Creators best Highlanders in 5 games. Creators win first 2, Highlanders win next 2, Creators prevail in game 5 5-1 behind Addie Joss and Sherry Magee. Magee had 9 RBIs in the series.

1911—Highlanders win 1st title as home team wins all 5-games. Ray Collins wins his 2nd game of the series beating the Roses Ed Walsh. Birdie Cree is the hitting star with 3 RBIs.

1915—Down 2 games to 1 and 1 out away from elimination, Braggo Roth hits a 2-run HR to tie game #4. Highlanders go on to win in 12 ins allowing Rube Foster to win game 5 4-0. The losing Bucs almost become the first(and only) team to win a title after having a losing regular season record.

1918—Titan's win in 5-games vs. the Bullies for John Ambrose's first title. They faced elimination 5 times during the playoffs, and won all 5 games. George Sisler, Urban Shocker and Jack Quinn lead the way to the title in game 5. Game 1 was a 16 inning classic won by the Bullies 2-1 on Lefty Tyler's squeeze bunt.

1920—Bullies over the Creators in 5 games. Game 5 goes 14 innings with the Bullies winning 1-0 on a bases loaded walk. Creators miss 2 squeeze bunts during regulation that would have won the game/series.

1921—Bullies win in 5 games over the WhiteRoses. Third consecutive title for Dennis Chapman's Bullies.

1922—Creators win the first 2 games, Titans win the next 2, including a comeback 11 inning win in game 4. Game 5 was 4-3 Creators until the 9th when they score 3 to blow it open.

1925—Titans' win the title after trailing both playoff series 2 games to 0. Down 7-0 in game 4 vs. the Yellowjackets, they come back to win 11-7. Down 5-0 in game 5, they come back to win 8-6 to win the title. Game 5 goes to 11 innings until George Sisler hits a 2-run HR.

1928—Bats win in 5 games vs. Titans led by Herb Pennock's 2 wins.

1934—Creators win in 5 games over the Keystones. Up 2 games to 1 and winning game 4 5-0 into the 7th, the Keystones score 7 to force a game 5. Fritz Ostermueller scatters 10 hits in a 6-1 game 5 win.

1937—George App's RiverBandits win their first title in a 5-game series vs. the WhiteRoses.

1941—Exciting 5-game series win for the Mongols over the Creators as the home team wins every game. Creators in the lead game 5 until Dixie Walker's 3-run HR off of lefty Harry Eisenstat.

1942—Black Death win in 5 games vs. the Yannigans led by WSeries MVP Mike Chartak.

1945—Creators top WhiteRoses in 5 games. Game 5 is anti-climactic as Creators score 6 in the first inning to put the game away early.

1946—Roses beat Legend Killers in 5 games. Game 5 the Roses won on George McQuinn's 2-run double.

1950—Next Generation beat RiverDogs in 5 games. Warren Spahn wins game 5 for Joe's first title.

1952—Mongols win in 5 games over Mayflies(led by Tony.)
