## What is DISC?

Imagine learning to speak a new language in just a few hours. Everyone has a different way they prefer to communicate with others. DISC allows us to explore these differences in order to better understand ourselves. By understanding ourselves we are then able to understand why certain people are much easier to work with than others and why there may be tension with people that have different styles than us. In an interactive onsite workshop you will learn fundamentals that will allow you to enhance all the relationships in your lives. Once you get the basics down, you realize how impactful stretching to work with other styles can be.

DISC refers to four core sets of behavior styles. The various combinations of the following styles determine our own natural communication style (language).

Dominant How one solves problems and deals with challenges.

Influence How one expresses themselves around others.

Steady How one approaches developing a plan.

Compliant How one prefers to deal with procedures.

## What are some use cases for DISC?

- Team Building
- Communication Effectiveness
- Onboarding a new hire; will this person be a good fit for our team?
- 1:1 Coaching
- New Managers getting to know their teams

## How it works?

- Participants take an online assessment (30 questions)
- Assessments are then broken down into a workshop (2 4hs) or 1:
  1 coaching sessions (1 2hs)
- Desired Participants 10-25 max
