 - Comedic Relief - book with funny side character
 - hero support - graphic novel
 - mission strategy - non fiction

FAQ

what if i can't get a copy of group book?

you can try out libby or hoopla if you have a library card. you could also try scribe for a free two month trial (link) if any of those don't work then it's fine, group books aren't mandatory and they only help the group.

do i have to participate in all the challenges?

no, the challenges only help the groups so if you don't want to participate then you don't have to

can i switch teams?

you can't switch teams because once you're already on the spreadsheet it would be a lot of work to change you to another one.

do i have to pick a team right a way?

no, you have until May 31st to pick a team but after that you, if you haven't picked a team i'll put you in one.
