Whereas, the mission of the UNITERS committee is to serve as a voice for transfer students, among other student populations, and represent them in our initiatives;

Whereas, it is important the UNITERS committee members can hear from transfer students directly and focus on their concerns in UNITERS projects; and,

Whereas, UNITERS committee members seek to build connections with current transfer students and this can best be accomplished via in-person events; and,
