    - Selections from Walt Whitman
    - Selected Poems and works by Edgar Allen Poe
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### Unit 4: The Quest for Freedom (Weeks 10-12)

- **Focus:** Themes of freedom, identity, and social justice
- **Works:**
  - "An Occurrence at Owl Creek Bridge" by Ambrose Bierce

- “The Outlaws of Poker Flat” by Bret Harte
  - Selected speeches or essays on women’s and civil rights
  - Of Mice and Men by John Steinbeck
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## Unit 5: America Transformed (Weeks 13 -15)

- **Focus:** Change in American society, realism, and naturalism
- **Works:**
  - “Harlem” by Langston Hughes and other selections of Harlem Renaissance

### Poetry

  - Fiction and poetry reflecting societal shifts
