The Creative Arts Society is seeking four more artists to exhibit works at South Oaks Family Medicine in 2025. The venue is looking for **medium to large-scale abstracts, landscapes, photographs, and sculptural works that can be hung on a wall**. Two artists are needed per installation. The call will remain open until the spots are filled. This is a curated exhibit which means that artists are responsible for hanging their own art and creating their own labels.

South Oaks Family Medicine is part of the CAS Curated Exhibit program. At curated exhibits, the artist is completely responsible for their own installation and strike.

SPECIFICS

LOCATION: South Oaks Family Medicine, 8517 FM 1826 Bldg 2, Austin, Texas 78737

SIZE REQUIREMENTS:

Mid-range and large works

Max weight = 8 lbs.

Max height = 48"; Max width = 48"

Min size = 15" x 15"

Number of works required: 20 (10 pieces per artist)

Art must be family-friendly and able to hang on the wall. Abstract and landscape paintings, photographs (scenery, still life), assemblages, multimedia, wall sculptures.

Please, no overly cute images, portraits, or political subject matter.

Prints are acceptable as long as this is indicated in the label information.

HANGING REQUIREMENTS:

The venue will only allow the nails already in place; artists will need to use the existing nails.

2-D art must be wired for hanging with wire that will support your work. When pulled up, the wire should be no less than 2 inches from the top of the piece so that when hung the hanger will not show. Unframed canvas edges should be gallery wrapped.

Artists will print their own art tags for wall display. A link for the label template is provided on the above SignUp form.

SALES:

Artwork will hang for the entire show unless you have a sale. If you have a sale, you must contact

the venue coordinator and obtain their approval *before removing any art from the walls*. This is so that the venue coordinator can obtain the venue's permission in advance. You must hang a replacement piece with its label when you remove any artwork. CAS receives a 15% commission on all art sales made at our venues. The commission is to be paid within 15 days from the date of the sale. It is calculated based on the price of the artwork before sales tax and any credit card fees. It is the responsibility of the artist to ensure that State sales tax is paid on each work sold.

LIABILITY:

Neither CAS nor the venue assume any responsibility for loss, theft, or damage. Even though CAS will take all reasonable care to protect the art, CAS artists understand they are hanging art at their own risk.
