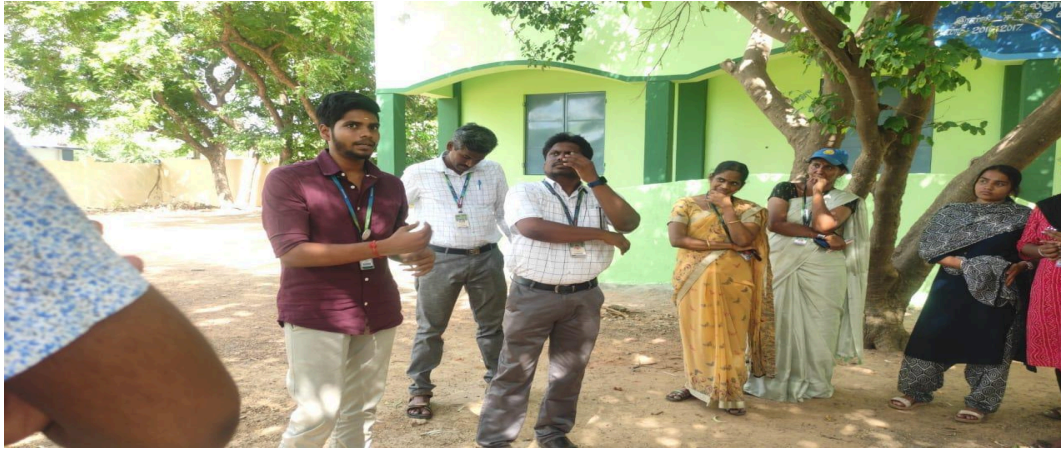
"Dynamic Gnimmergorp Series o(1)"
