

QR Codes for Tracking

Use QR Codes to track...

- When students go to the “calm down corner”
- “Buddy room”
- Missing homework
- OR whatever your school uses for students when they need to take a break from the classroom.

All you need to do is create a QR code, put it by the door or in your calm down spot and students scan the code each time they have to go to the area you are tracking. The QR code inputs the students name, date and TIME onto a google form.

Now you have instant documentation about how often a student is going to the calm down corner, and what times of day (so you can see if there is a pattern). Having a QR code in place means you don't have to interrupt your lesson to document the student behavior and you don't have to try to remember to do it later.
