Articles are written with a line density of 1.0 spacing, Times New Roman 12 font size. The total number of pages of the article is between 11 and 25 pages. The first paragraph of each sub-chapter does not need to be indented. The second paragraph and so on of each sub-chapter must be indented. The introduction section should explain the initial phenomenon of the research; explanation of the grand theory; relationship between variables; research gap; explanation of the object and motivation of the research; and the purpose of the research.

The citation writing in this manuscript uses Harvard style, such as Cite Them Right Harvard or other Harvard writing styles. To facilitate the citation process and compilation of bibliographies, authors are advised to use the Mendeley Desktop application, which can be downloaded via the following link:






Figure 1. Research Framework




Figure 2. Path Analysis Test Results

Make sure every source cited in the text is listed in the reference list, and vice versa, all references in the list must be cited in the article.
