

Rules

If there are any disagreements, call over someone in charge and their decision will be final.

- Rally scoring.
- Players do not need to "rotate" in serve receive, but they do need to rotate their server.
- Teams may make 1 substitution per set (when a player subs out they can not return for that set).
- A hand set that travels over the net is legal if the ball is set perpendicular to the setter's shoulders.
- A "touch" on a block does not count as a hit.
- Indoor setting rules apply relative to the level of play.
- Open hand receiving is allowed as long as it is within the normal rules.
- Open-hand "tips" are not allowed.
- Let serves (when the serve hits the net before crossing over) is a redo and the point is replayed.
- All four players are "front row" and can attack above the plane of the net.
- Open division is one set to 30, win by 2.
- Casual division is best of 3 sets, first and second to 21, third (if needed) to 15, win by 2.
- If you are not playing you are scorekeeping, additionally we need spectators to scorekeep some games.
