



Announcement of Phunphin Provincial Police Station

Subject: Declaration of Intent Not to Accept Gifts or Any Other Benefits from the Performance of Duties (No Gift Policy)

Fiscal Year B.E. 2569 (2026)

Phunphin Provincial Police Station is committed to developing its operations with transparency, placing public interest above personal interest, and preventing conflicts of interest. This commitment is in line with the government development policy under the National Strategy Master Plan on Anti-Corruption and Misconduct, which aims to ensure transparent administration and that all state officials do not accept gifts or any other benefits arising from the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy).

Therefore, in accordance with such intention and the ethical standards of Phunphin Provincial Police Station, this is to declare the intention of Police Colonel Nipol Chatree, Superintendent of Phunphin Provincial Police Station, together with all police officers under his command, not to accept gifts or any other benefits of any kind from the performance of duties, whether before, during, or after duty.

All personnel shall strictly comply with the regulations of the National Anti-Corruption Commission regarding the acceptance of assets or any other benefits by state officials by virtue of ethics, B.E. 2563 (2020), in order to jointly create an organizational culture of integrity, reject patronage systems, avoid any actions that may affect discretion or decision-making in the performance of duties leading to discrimination, unfair practices, or conflicts of interest, and to build public confidence in the fair and transparent exercise of official duties under good governance principles.

This announcement is hereby made known to all concerned and shall be strictly observed.
