II. BRIEF CONTEXT/PERSPECTIVE OF THE ACTIVITY

In our school community, we observe that while many students express a desire to contribute to environmental protection, they often do not know where or how to participate in local green initiatives. Opportunities such as tree planting, community clean-up drives, or urban gardening are usually conducted by the local government, yet many students remain unaware of these activities or how they can get involved. This situation shows a gap between students' willingness to help and their actual engagement in real-world environmental actions, emphasizing the need for a bridge that connects the youth with community-based sustainability programs.

This challenge stems from the lack of proper coordination and information dissemination between schools and the local government. Because of this, students miss out on meaningful experiences that promote environmental awareness, social responsibility, and civic engagement, we are called to live our faith through action and stewardship of God's creation. Seeing this disconnection inspires us to create a pathway for students to participate in activities. Through reflection, we realize that environmental responsibility begins with awareness, grows through participation, and flourishes through shared commitment.

In response, we developed the **SSLGreen Project**, a program designed to connect students directly with the local government's environmental initiatives. This project aims to give students the opportunity to participate in green movements such as tree planting, waste segregation campaigns, and community gardening. It promotes collaboration between the SSLG, the student body, and local environmental offices, fostering a sense of unity and shared responsibility for the environment. The beneficiaries of this program will be the students, the local community, and the environment itself.
