Application procedure for students

Nomination	Erasmus Exchange students must first be nominated by their home university via email (to: pjint@pjwstk.edu.pl) Nomination should include the following information about the applicant: ➤ name and surname, ➤ e-mail address, ➤ area and level of studies, ➤ mobility period (semester/s, academic year).
Nomination deadlines	1st semester: 15th of May 2nd semester: 15th of October
Application docs deadlines	1st semester: 30th of May 2nd semester: 30th of October
Application	The International Office's Team will email nominated students a link to an online application form. You can find a link to the form also at PJAiT International Exchange's website. While filling the form, students will be asked to attach: • CV (.pdf); • a photo for a student ID card (jpg / png); • Learning Agreement (.pdf) - a copy from the OLA system; signed by coordinator and the student Bachelor's Degree Computer Science [EN] • PJAiT details for the OLA - in the doc linked here • Art / Design students will be asked to attach their portfolio: as a PDF file, or as a link to an online portfolio Masters Degree Computer Science [EN] Portfolio requirements for graphic design / interior design applicants.

Language of study

PJAiT offers full English paths, MA and BA level, at the Information Technology, New Media Art and the Information Management departments. All courses and tutoring is held in English.

Exchange students who don't speak Polish are advised to choose courses from PJAIT's English paths for their mobility period at PJAIT.

Nevertheless, exchange students are welcome to choose Polish path courses too (B2 Polish required).

Some Graphics classes at the Polish path can be delivered in English if an exchange student joins it.

The Interior Design study path (part of the New Media Department) at PJAIT is offered in Polish only. However, the staff provides individual mentorship for Erasmus+ students in English.

Required language skills	English / Polish: B2 (CEFR scale).
Language courses	Erasmus students are free to attend any language courses administered by the PJAIT's Foreign Languages Department (sjo@pja.edu.pl). The Languages Department provides English, Polish, German, Russian, Italian and Spanish courses. Joining the basic Japanese courses is also possible. The Japanese language education is managed by the Japanese Culture Department

Insurance

Insurance	All Erasmus students must provide medical, accident and travel insurance for themselves. Insurance should include the cost of repatriation (assisted transfer of a person back to their home country in case of serious injury or illness). The insurance has to cover the entire period of stay at Polish-Japanese Academy of Information Technology. EU students should also hold a valid European Health Insurance Card (EHIC card). Incoming students should share a copy of their insurance doc with PJAIT's International Office, before their mobility period.
