You will be working on an annotated bibliography for your term paper. By the time this assignment is completed, you should have a majority, if not all, of your research completed for your paper. This assignment will give you the opportunity to organize your research, as well as show me how much of it you have completed. This assignment is another step in completing your final paper assignment. This is intended to help you with completing your 7-10 page paper. The assignments such as this will give you the groundwork so that writing your final paper will be simply putting your other assignments together into a formalized work.

The annotated Bibliography is a way to gather your thoughts regarding your research. This also implies that your research is mostly completed. When you are doing your research, you should have a good idea of how this research will be utilized within your paper. The organization of your research in your paper relies heavily on understanding how it will be useful to you within the paper. This means that you will need to have a good idea of what is your thesis that you are trying to prove along with your main points to prove that thesis. You should also have an idea of a refutation that you will be including in your paper. Your thesis should already be set by your abstract.

- This will need to be formatted in Chicago Style Format
- Must include at least 5 sources (at least 2 must be books) **Must be the full citation.**
- Must include a paragraph for each source
- Must be a description of the source and how you are going to use the source in your paper.
