PVP- 1 unique accounting class (ACCT 603 - Energy Accounting), 2 finance electives, 3 unique Petroleum Engineering classes
Technology (Both) - 6 ISTM unique including 1 elective class
Marketing - 7 MKTG Classes, including 1 elective, has 2 ACCT electives
Nonprofit (Both) - 4 Public Service & Administration classes 2 of which are electives
Tax - None has 2 ACCT class electives
Wealth Management/Financial Planning - 5 Financial Planning Classes
Supply Chain - 6 SCMT classes, 1 ISTM, and 1 ACCT elective
Human Resources - 7 HRM electives and 2 ACCT electives

Accounting Certificate Programs:

Both programs have a student member organization you must be a part of, but they have lighter time commitments, with 2-3 meetings per semester needed. They both also have an application process, but you can opt-in to both if you are in PPA. The applications are also relatively easy and have easy requirements to join.
