 - Firstly, job FULFILLMENT directly impacts our well-being and mental health. When we are content with our job, it significantly contributes to our happiness and engagement. For instance, being satisfied with our work creates a positive environment, fosters better relationships with colleagues, and reduces stress levels.

 - Therefore, focusing on finding pleasure in our work should be a primary consideration when making career choices.
