# First Things First: installing Equatio for Google Chrome and finding your Product Code

To install Equatio for Google Chrome, you need to add it from the **Chrome Web Store**.

Once Equatio for Google Chrome has been added, you'll see a blue diamond icon with your Chrome extensions:




## **Activating Equatio With Your Product Code**

When you purchase Equatio, we will email you your Equatio Product Code. Once you've received your Product Code you can activate your license.

- 1. When activating your license, you must be signed into Chrome with the account you intend to use for the subscription. To check to make sure you're signed in with the correct account, type chrome://settings in the address bar and that will show how you're signed into Chrome.
- 2. Once you've verified you're signed in with the account to be used with Equatio, open up a Google Doc and click on the blue diamond Equatio logo within your extensions list






**3.** This will then open the toolbar with limited features (freemium version) and you'll see the blue Equatio icon on the left end of the toolbar glow yellow alerting you to the freemium version:



- **4.** You should be prompted to choose an account and confirm permissions here. Click **Allow** when prompted.
- **5.** Once permissions have been allowed, click the Equatio button on the left end of the toolbar:




6. Select Options:





## 7. Then go to Premium:



- 8. Enter your Product Code in the box.
- 9. Click the Activate button.
- **10.** Then click **OK** to close the Options window. You should then no longer see the blinking yellow alert on the toolbar.



### **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### What's included with my Equatio subscription?

Your subscription includes Equatio for Google Chrome, Equatio for Windows, Equatio for Mac, access to Equatio mathspace, and Equatio mobile.

#### Can I customize the toolbar?

You can easily hide and move buttons on the Equatio for Google Chrome toolbar by clicking on the Equatio button at the left end of the toolbar, then go to Options > Toolbar Options. You can turn off the features you want to hide by sliding the button for each feature to the left. Slide the button to the right to restore a feature to the toolbar. After any change, please click the Save button.
