### **ADVANCE ASSIGNMENTS FOR INTENSIVE COURSES AND OBSERVANCE OF RELIGIOUS HOLIDAYS**

A class syllabus including any advance reading and/or writing assignments for intensive classes will be posted to Courses 3-4 weeks prior to the start of class. Please note that it is each student's responsibility to review the syllabus well before the class begins and complete any advance assignments. Students who show up the first day unprepared risk being dropped from the class.

If a student intends to miss one or more classes for religious observance in an intensive course (i.e., one that runs for a shorter period than a regular semester term), he or she must notify the Straus Office prior to registering for that intensive course to determine whether such absences would fundamentally alter the nature of the intensive course.

### **EXTERNSHIP ENROLLMENT**

Students cannot register for externships through WaveNet. All students are required to have their externship placement confirmed with the Straus office before they can register. All externships should be completed within the semester registered unless prior permission has been granted for extension. International students wanting to enroll in an externship must be approved for CPT and should check in with the Office of International Student Services (OISS) to confirm eligibility.

### **DROPPING/WITHDRAWING FROM CLASSES**

The deadline for withdrawing from **one week or weekend intensive** classes is **7 days before the class starts**. The deadline for withdrawing from all other Straus classes is **before the second class begins**. You must email [Law Student Information](#) a fully completed [add/drop form](#) in order to be dropped from the class. Failure to drop an intensive course by this deadline will result in a grade of W or F and/or the student owing all or a portion of the tuition for the class.

Please note that any student who drops all of their classes during the summer will be charged a \$150 withdrawal fee.
