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- **Arrival and Hotel Check-In:**

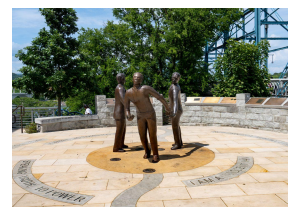
- Hotel: Atlanta Airport Marriott, 4711 Best Rd, Atlanta, GA 30337

Friday, October 24

- **Breakfast at Hotel**

- **8:00 AM:** Depart for Montgomery, AL. (Approx. 2 hours, 150 miles)
- **10:00 AM:** Contextualization talk on events leading to Rosa Parks' arrest and the (CST) bus boycott.
- **10:30 AM:** Visit to the Rosa Parks Museum.
 - Stand where the Civil Rights Movement began and learn about the Montgomery Bus Boycott.
- **12:30 PM:** Lunch @ Martha's Place (Southern Buffet)
- **2:00 PM:** Memorial for Peace and Justice – Lynching Memorial.



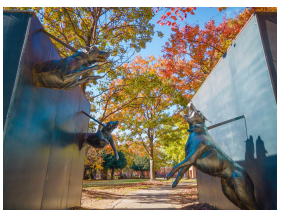
- Reflect on an often-overlooked tragedy at the first national memorial for victims of lynching.



- **3:30 PM:** Equal Justice Initiative's Legacy Museum.
 - Explore the evolution of racial oppression, from slavery to mass incarceration.
- **5:15 PM:** Visit the Mothers of Gynecology Monument.
- **6:00 PM:** Dinner (on your own) in downtown Montgomery.

Saturday, October 25

- **Breakfast at Hotel**
- **8:30 AM:** Depart for downtown Montgomery.
- **9:00 AM:** Visit the Equal Justice Initiative's Freedom Sculpture Garden.
- **10:00 AM:** Depart for Selma (Approx. 1 hour, 55 miles), with box lunches provided.
- **12:15 PM:** Tour Selma & The Edmund Pettus Bridge.
 - Meet with a survivor of the march who shares her personal story.
- **2:15 PM:** Depart for Birmingham.
- **4:15 PM:** Contextualization talk on Birmingham. (Approx. 2 hours, 90 miles)
- **4:30 PM:** Walking tour of Freedom Park & 16th Street Baptist Church.





- A Reverend, who was a Civil Rights worker in Birmingham in the 50s & 60s, will guide the tour. Hear his personal experiences of being arrested and attacked by dogs and hoses.
- Visit the historic church where four girls died in a bombing.
- **5:45 PM:** Dinner at Pizitz Food Hall.
- **6:30 PM:** Depart for Atlanta. (Approx. 2 hours, 145 miles)
- **10:00 PM:** Arrive at Atlanta Airport (EST).

Sunday, October 26

- **Breakfast at Hotel**
- **8:30 AM:** Depart hotel.
- **9:00 AM:** Tour the King Center and Auburn Street neighborhood.
 - See the historic neighborhood where Dr. King was born, preached, and is buried.
- **10:00 AM:** Sunday morning services at Ebenezer Baptist Church, Dr. King's historic church.
- **11:45 AM:** Lunch at Ponce City Market (on your own).
- **1:00 PM:** Depart for the airport.
- **1:20 PM:** Drop-off at the airport.
- **3:30 PM:** Earliest departure time for return flights.
