 aides but it will take months.

Prop 28: Chris shared that he is working with Malibu Theater to bring a Holiday show to MES and to bring an all-new lunchtime theater with an after-school component. Rhapsody music starts in February. Supplementary supplies will be bought for our Visual Arts Program.

Site Council Members serve for 2 years. On the first meeting positions are determined for that year.. You can not transfer your membership...all members are elected and voted in. No conflicts of interest. Amy is the Secretary, keeps track of all meetings, turns the minutes into Chris each week and maintains a record of all meeting notes for the year.

Fall Achievement data: <u>Chris screenshared the test scores/data and explained the results.</u> We are off to a stronger start than last year in READING, our fall STAR 2024-25 reading data is comparatively higher than our fall 2023-24 & winter 2023-24 scores.

- a. AR is starting to take off at MES. So far 28 students have taken a quiz. Now that we have received Goal-setting training, it's time to set goals and have students start quizzing on books they have read.
- b. Fall Star testing has concluded. Our fall Star reading scores are higher than last fall or even last winter. Math is higher too than this time last year. Fall Star Early Literacy is higher than last year too and is equal to our highest scores ever.
