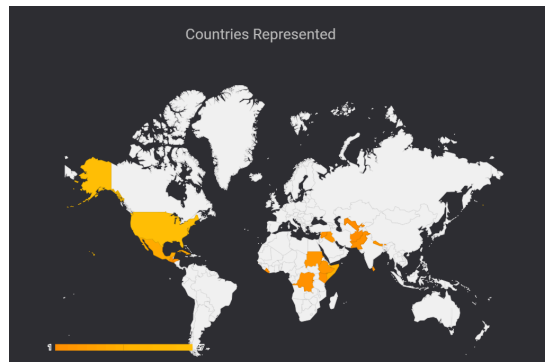


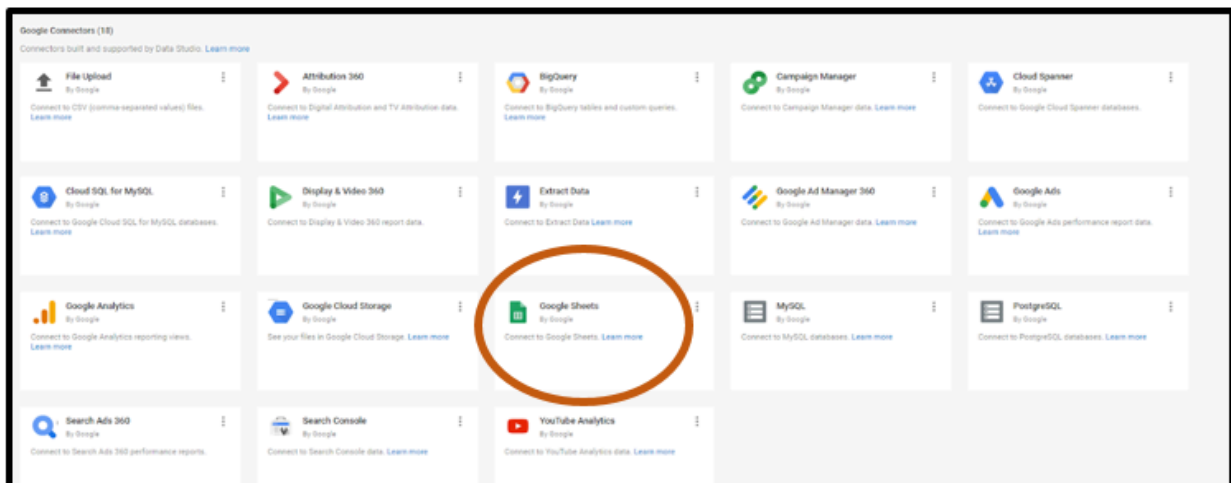
How to Create a Map of Countries Represented in Your Classroom/School



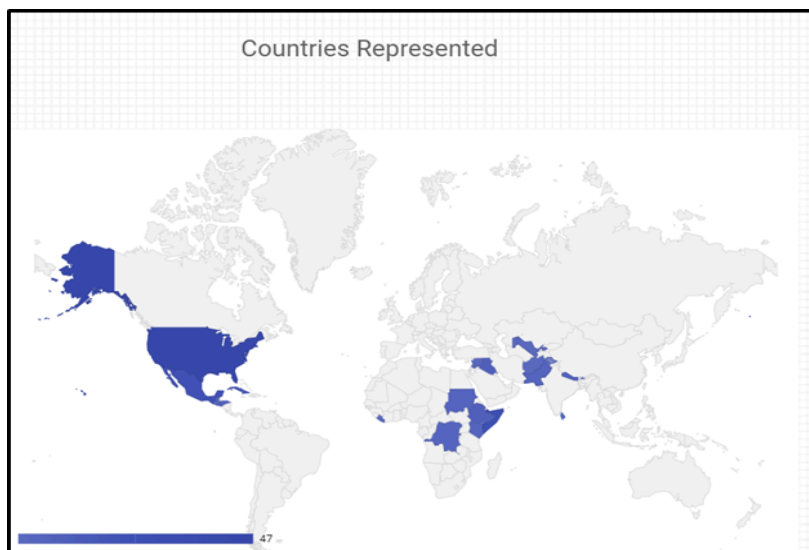
1. Login to Google
2. Go to **sheets.google.com**
3. Click on the + to start a new blank spreadsheet, name it
4. Create 2 columns: **Countries** and **Number of Students**
5. In the Countries column list your students countries of birth
6. In the Number of Students column, indicate the total number of students in your class/school from that country

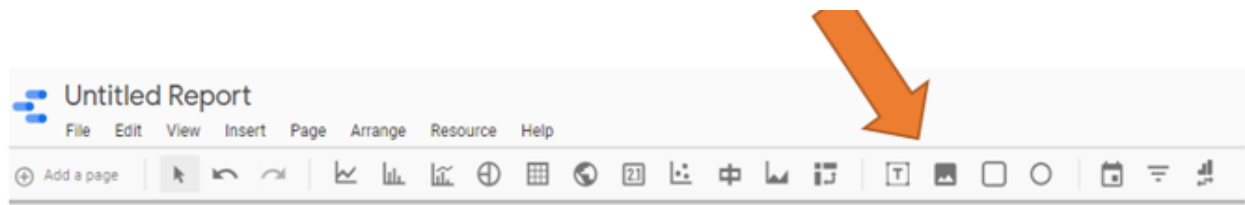
7. Go to **datastudio.google.com**
8. If this is your first time using it, a Welcome to Google Data Studio window will appear. Click **Get Started** then click **Accept** the Studio's Terms and Condition. Finally, set your email preferences and click **Done**
9. Click on the **+** to start a new blank report
10. In the bottom right corner click  **CREATE NEW DATA SOURCE** This may take a few seconds.
11. Select Google Sheets



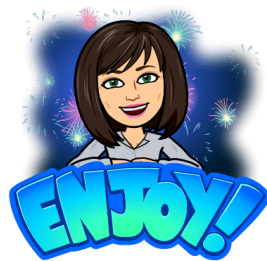
12. Click **Authorize** then **Allow** for Google Studio to access your Google Account
13. Select the spreadsheet you just created and click **Connect** in the top right corner of the page then **Add to Report**
14. Click on **Insert** then select **Geo Map** (globe) and click anywhere on your report. Expand the Geo Map.



15. Click on  to upload a picture or logo of your school and  to insert headings



16. Click outside of the map to deselect it and decide on your **Theme** (simple dark or simple)
17. Click back on the map to view the **Style** menu and change the color of the countries, background, etc. (if your wish)
18. Click on **View** at the top of the page and enjoy your interactive map.



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
