

# ILLINOIS ASSOCIATION OF JUNIOR HIGH STUDENT COUNCILS CODE OF CONDUCT

The Illinois Association of Junior High Student Councils is an organization that promotes the acquisition of leadership skills. To that end, we expect our student leaders to be role models of appropriate behavior. All delegates who participate in IAJHSC sponsored activities should . . .

1. Attend all sessions at the designated times and places. Delegates should be attentive during all sessions and display the manners expected of an audience. Nametags, buttons, and/or identification items should be worn at all times and be clearly visible.
2. Behave in a responsible manner so as not to endanger their health, safety, and welfare, or the health, safety, and welfare of others.
3. Dress in attire that is appropriate, whether casual or dress-up. The following may not be worn: short shorts, short skirts, tops with spaghetti straps, strapless tops, crop tops, chains, and cut out or frayed clothing. Stomachs, midriiffs, and backs may not be bare. Clothing may not contain any reference to alcohol, tobacco, drugs, or sexual behavior. Delegates who do not follow this dress code will be asked to change their clothes.
4. Understand that the use of alcohol, tobacco products, or illegal drugs is strictly prohibited. Any delegate found in possession or under the influence of any of the above while attending a leadership workshop or state convention will be placed in the direct supervision of his/her advisor and denied further participation in IAJHSC activities. The parents of any delegate found in possession or under the influence of any of the above while attending summer leadership camp will be informed and told to remove their child from camp without delay.
5. Remain in the IAJHSC supervised environment at all times.
6. Respect the property of others and not take or damage items belonging to other individuals, a hotel housing state convention delegates, a host school, or the camp facility.

The IAJHSC Executive Director will notify the principal of the delegate's school of any infraction of the IAJHSC Code of Conduct.
