

#### Step 1: Make an account

----- DO NOT include any grades, etc.


## Screenshot Keys

Mouse Shortcuts: Click initials in top right corner → Preferences → Set Pan/Zoom/Orbit to Solidworks



Sets MiddleMouseButton  $\to$  ROTATE Sets CTRL+MiddleMouseButton  $\to$  SLIDE Sets Roll MiddleMouseButton  $\to$  Zoom IN/OUT
