



Covid Game Day Procedures

Welcome to ROWVA High School. Please review the following document so that we can have a safe and positive experience along with an efficient use of time!

Spectators-Due to the limitations on spectators all games played at ROWVA High School will be livestreamed. Link will be emailed to you the day of the game. Your school will be responsible for printing 100 tickets for the varsity football game you play at RHS. A copy of the ticket should be sent to Grant Gullstrand by Thursday the week of the game. The gates will open at 5:30 PM. They will enter through the double gates of the field directly behind the goal posts in the north endzone. From there they will be required to stay on the visiting side of the field with masks on. Please send an administrator to monitor your fans. There will be two portable bathrooms for them to use.

Bus Arrival-We ask that you do not arrive more than 2 hours prior to your scheduled game time. Upon arrival, please pull the team bus up to the front of the high school to drop off your team. Your team will use our girls locker room to change. Once your team has been unloaded, we ask the bus to drive to the gravel sophomore lot next to our administration building. The bus driver may sit on the same side of the bleachers as their team.

COVID screening-At this time, we will not require a temperature/symptoms check for the visiting football team upon arrival. We trust your school will handle this properly on their own.

Masks- Masks are required upon entering the field and must be worn properly covering your nose and mouth.

Officials-May use the officials room like normal.

Concessions-We will not be offering concessions.

End of Game- At the conclusion of the game, we will not shake hands, but we will allow the coach to meet and display sportsmanship for both teams.

Pressbox- The second level of the press box will be available for away team use.

Home Tickets- Each senior football player and cheerleader will receive five tickets to pass out. Each junior will receive four tickets to pass out. Each sophomore will receive three tickets to pass out and each freshman will receive two tickets to pass out. General admission tickets will be available for students beginning on Wednesday April 7 at 8:00 AM. Each student will be limited to one ticket. Anyone else may call into any of the three school's offices beginning Thursday to try and get a ticket. These tickets will be limited to two per person when coming to pick up tickets. They are first come, first serve.
