2. NO ENTRY FEE WILL BE CHARGED TO EXHIBIT.
3. THERE IS NO AGE LIMIT TO ENTER.
4. EXHIBITORS ARE LIMITED TO ONE ENTRY IN EACH NUMBERED SECTION. PROTECTION MUST BE USED ON EXHIBITS THAT WOULD BE DAMAGED BY DUST; PROVIDE ONE END OPEN FOR JUDGING.
5. THE COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE DAMAGED OR SOILED ARTICLES.
6. ANY ARTICLE ENTERED IN PREVIOUS YEARS IN OPEN CLASS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
7. ARTICLES MADE FOR COMPETITION MUST HAVE BEEN COMPLETED WITHIN THE PAST TWO YEARS, EXCEPT FOR QUILTS WHICH MUST HAVE BEEN COMPLETED IN THE PAST THREE YEARS, EXCLUDING ANTIQUE QUILTS.
8. IF NO COMPETITION EXISTS AND ARTICLES ARE NOT WORTHY OF PLACING, NONE WILL BE AWARDED.
9. NO OPEN JUDGING.
10. JUDGING WILL BE CLOSED TO EVERYONE EXCEPT THE COMMITTEE.
11. EVERY PRECAUTION WILL BE TAKEN TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF THE ARTICLES ENTERED. COMMITTEE MEMBERS WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE LOSS OR DAMAGE OF ANY ARTICLE. CASES WILL BE LOCKED AT ALL TIMES.

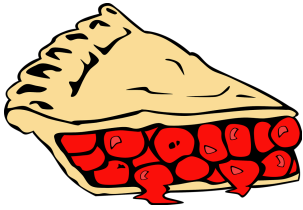

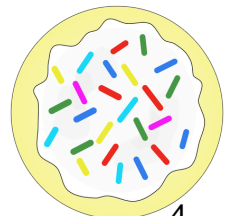
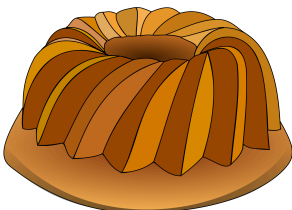

If it's a family recipe you don't want to indulge, a list of ingredients must be included. All entries must be wrapped in either plastic, foil, or ziploc bags, or in a plastic container. A portion of the product will remain for display and the remainder will be sold at the food auction. Please read the auction information.

Any portion of the product on display that begins to spoil will be disposed of , but the name of the exhibitor and the placing will be displayed for public viewing.
