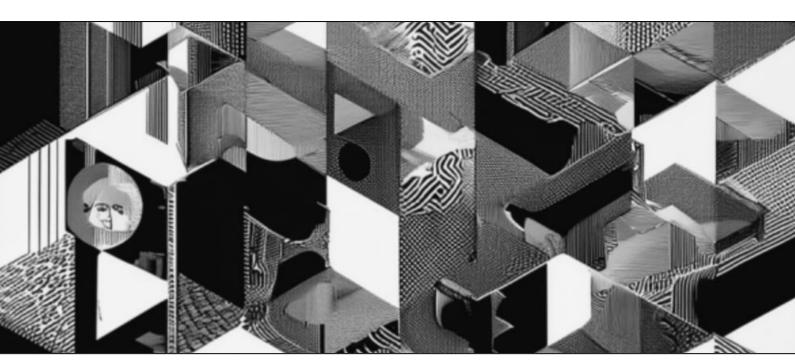






EXPLORING COORDI-NATIONS & NETWORK SOVEREIGNTIES



RESEARCH WORKSHOP AND PUBLIC CONFERENCE

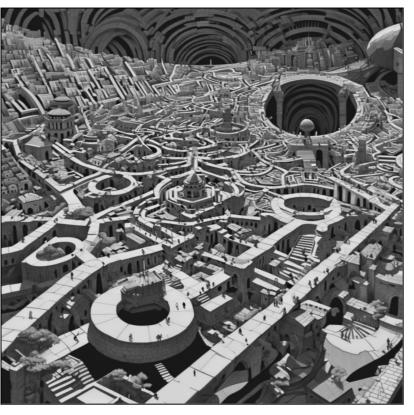

HEALDSBURG, CA

The traditional concept of "sovereignty." once seen as a quality exclusive to nation-states, is changing. Thanks to advancements in digital technology, particularly in new decentralized technologies, we are moving towards more dynamic, inclusive, and network-driven governance models. This shift has been referred to as the emergence of Network Sovereignties, which include innovative concepts like Network States and Coordi-nations.

From 17-27 June 2024, a group of thinkers and practitioners will convene in Healdsburg, CA, for an intensive workshop exploring how commons-based approaches can be applied to the development of Coordi-nations. The workshop will be held in the framework of Edge Esmeralda, a month-long pop-up village dedicated to exploring the intersection of cutting-edge technologies and new regenerative ways of living. This initiative is organized by Edge City, an organization born out of the Zuzalu ecosystem that convenes people working at the frontiers of tech, science, and society in popup villages across the globe.

WHAT ARE COORDI-NATIONS?



Coordi-nations are network sovereignties that enhance global collaboration and self-governance through information and communication technologies. Contrary to other examples of network sovereignties, such as Network States,

Coordi-nations don't seek to replace nation-states. Rather, they prioritize participatory governance and decentralized decision-making in a self-contained domain that exists parallel to the state. This approach reimagines "nations" in a digital context and leverages modern tech to reimagine sovereignty beyond the confines of the monopoly of the use of force over delimited territories.

GOALS OF THE EVENT

The workshop's goal is to cement a community of practice among innovative thinkers and builders who aspire to redefine sovereignty in the digital age. This workshop will be the breeding ground for a collaborative ecosystem where collective strategies are developed to prototype and implement Coordi-nations. Each session will come with a moderator, timekeeper, and notetaker. We encourage participants to adopt the "yes, and..." communication strategy.

Participants will build on the learnings and insights gathered during the **first edition of the Coordi-nations workshop** at Zuzalu in May 2023 and the research conducted on the topic in the year since.

EXPECTED OUTCOMES

- 1. Analyzing the networks of communities that emerged from Zuzalu, including Edge City.
- 2. Elaborating an operational framework and plan for turning the Zuzalu "archipelago" into a Coordi-nation. This includes developing a strategic and tactical approach to mutualize resources and engage in collective action amongst the different spin-offs.
- 3. Implementing the insights at the event's next edition, which will take place in Thailand from October to November 2024.

HOW IS THE WORKSHOP STRUCTURED?

The workshop will gather 20–30 selected participants, including "residents" of Edge Esmeralda and "visitors" traveling solely for this event, some of whom also participated in the first edition of the Coordi-nations workshop.

The main event is divided into a series of sub-events, including:

- 1 day-long onboarding session
- 3-days intensive workshop
- 1 weekend of fun and leisure activities
- 1 day-long public conference
- 1 day-long public workshop for collective scheming
- 2-day-long internal session for debriefing and documentation

We will share the workshop's outcomes through panels, presentations, and interactive workshops to engage the broader community.
JUNE 25	HYPERSTITION DAY During the hyperstition day, we will craft a step-by-step action plan to evolve proto-Network Sovereignties into fully formed entities. We will establish a tailored strategy to shape and grow the Zuzalu/ Edge City archipelago. - Still a public conference - Invite people to reflect on their projects in the context of coordi-nations.
JUNE 26-27	INTERNAL DEBRIEF & DOCUMENTATION Finally, we will reconvene in a private event to share our insights and experiences emerging during the workshop and finalize the relevant documentation.
