Actions against Global Warming and Climate Change

The United Nations General Assembly,

Grieved by the recent confirmations by scientific communities that the undoubtedly catastrophic phenomenon of climate change is worsening,

Deeply concerned about the worldwide tendency of climate change denial and the extreme spread of pseudo-scientific theories,

Taking into consideration the number of civil initiatives that have numerous times called for international cooperation and agreement concerning global warming,

- 1. *Proposes* the creation of a United Nations Climate Change and Global Warming committee, to focus on securing a bipartisan agreement on the matter,
- 2. Asks all countries to invest more money as percent of their Gross Domestic Product in scientific research about the environment, so that the main causes of global warming can be traced back and eliminated,
- 3. *Urges* the newly founded committee to draft a universally accepted treaty, which will revise the current laws regarding climate change,
- 4. *Requests* all national governments to abide by the treaty and create laws that will improve the situation of the environment in their country by:
 - a. Imposing fines on businesses and corporations that exceed the limits of greenhouse gas emissions
 - b. Maintaining the standards set by the United Nations by:
 - i. Funding civil initiatives
 - ii. Establishing a nationwide curriculum in schools that will emphasize on the importance of protecting the climate and the environment, so that the newer generations can avoid actions that contribute to global warming
