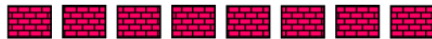

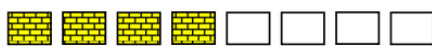

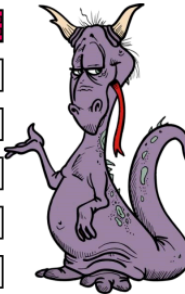

ALWAYS: SIEMPRE
USUALLY: CASI SIEMPRE
OFTEN: A MENUDO
SOMETIMES: A VECES
RARELY: POCAS VECES
NEVER: NUNCA

- We use **ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY** between the person and the principal verb. (Usamos los adverbios de frecuencia entre la persona y el verbo, excepto el verbo to be)
- We use **ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY** after the verb to be (Usamos los adverbios de frecuencia después del verbo to be)
