Great Western Network - Financial Guidelines

Annual Membership Fees:

All GWN member schools: \$4,000 per year.

Members of the Public Schools in Bismarck, Mandan and Minot as well as GWN member ND State colleges are not assessed a membership fee unless they agree to accept the financial responsibility of a private school in their city. Conditional upon: (a) they are a sending site only, (b) their own students do not receive ITV instruction and (c) they provide an ITV "sending" classroom within their building/district/campus upon request.) This conditional waiver is evaluated during the fall billing process.

Tuition Costs Per Student - Regular ITV & CTE courses

GWN Members: \$600 per student per full year course / \$300 per student per ½ year course.

Non GWN Members but have membership in another ND ITV consortium: **\$700** per student per full year course / **\$350** per student per ½ year course.

Schools that are not members of an ITV consortium in ND will not be allowed to receive a GWN ITV class.

<u>College and Dual Credit courses</u> No reimbursement and/or stipends are given to teachers or schools from GWN for a college taught course. GWN does not charge tuition. The college handles all financials and billings for tuition.

Reimbursement Rates from GWN to Schools holding their ITV teachers contract

When there are 8 or more students at receiving sites, the sending school will receive a reimbursement from GWN for \$8,000 per class taught.

When there are less than 8 *students at receiving sites*, the sending school will receive a reimbursement from GWN for **\$4,000** per class taught.

Teacher Stipend Rate per ITV class taught – (non GWN contracted teachers)

With 8 or more students at receiving sites: ITV teacher will receive a reimbursement from GWN (sent to the teachers school business manager) for \$3,000. (tffr & fica are to be paid by the sending school funds)

With less than 8 students at receiving sites: ITV teacher will receive a reimbursement from GWN (sent to the teachers school business manager) for \$2,000. (tffr & fica are to be paid by the sending school funds)

• The school business manager will incorporate the stipend reimbursement amount into their payroll for the teacher.

GWN Contracted Teacher Stipend

\$1,000 per period taught by consortium contracted teacher. (maximum \$4,000) (The LEA holds the contract)
