

Diamonds Code of Conduct

In order to provide a safe environment in which all students have an opportunity to learn, the Diamonds will expect the following Code of Conduct in all classrooms:

All the following violations can result in a strike:

- Tardy for class or activity
- Unprepared (book, pencil, homework as determined by team)
- Disrespect (speaking out)
- Not following directions/off task
- Horseplay
- No passes

Consequences

- On the 5th strike = 1 hour detention
- On the 10th strike = 1 hour detention
- The 15th strike will result in an office referral - with a recommendation for a Friday Night School
- The 20th strike will result in an office referral - with a recommendation for in school suspension (ISS)
- The 25th strike will result in an office referral - with a recommendation for 2 days of ISS and removal of privileges.
- The 30th strike will result in an office referral - with a recommendation for the extended day program
- Any further strikes are up to the team's discretion

In the case of a severe class disruption, students will be sent to the office immediately with an office referral.
