In filling out the application (both the [2026 D'Evelyn Summer School Registration](#) and this form), signing it, and submitting it, the student and his/her parent/legal guardian agree to the following terms of the D'Evelyn Summer School Mathematics Program.

1. This signed and dated form must be submitted/mailed to your math teacher by May 29th. You must also complete the [2026 D'Evelyn Summer School Registration](#). If this is not completed by May 29, you will NOT be able to take math summer school.
2. The student agrees to do all the required work in the summer school packet to the best of his/her ability, and to submit this work to the D'Evelyn mathematics summer school teacher as scheduled. Please note: If you are repeating a class, work done during the school year may not be used for summer credit, and work done for summer school may not be turned in during the school year. **Late work will not be accepted.**
3. **Class will not be held formally unless there is a scheduled test.** Every other week, you will attend class in-person to take a test (see schedule above). The test will be held from 9:00-10:00 am. Students may arrive at 8:00 am, if they would like to ask the teacher any questions in person. There are also two tutoring sessions Tuesday mornings. See calendar. Students who have questions should email the teacher at any time. The teacher will respond within 24 hours. If a student would like to work with the teacher via Google Meet, they can set up a time on Thursday mornings. A student who cannot take the final exam on the scheduled date must notify the summer school instructor to make other arrangements. **There is an additional \$50 fee for rescheduled final exams.**
4. By taking the final, the student agrees that a final course grade (with appropriate credit earned) will be placed on his/her official transcript, and that such a grade will be averaged in with the grades earned from other courses the student has taken for the purposes of calculating the student's cumulative grade point average (GPA). (If you are repeating a class, your summer school grade does not replace the grade that you previously earned. It is recorded on your transcript in addition to the prior grade.)
5. The final course grade will be weighted as follows: 10% for the homework packet (based upon both completion and quality of work) and 90% for tests. A course percentage of at least 70% (C-) must be earned for all courses to move to the next level of mathematics in the sequence at D'Evelyn if the student is on grade level. Students who are a year ahead in math need a B (80%) or better to move forward. Students who are two years ahead in math need an A (90%) or better to move forward.
6. **Whether or not the summer school course is completed, your text book and answer key must be returned by the date of the summer school final to avoid a \$10 late fee.**
7. **Summer School fees for full year will be \$180/ semester credit (\$360 total).**
