

New Grad Student Checklist: Fall 2025

Do before June 23rd/ASAP

Activate your NetID & Wiscmail

- a. In the ID number or Activation Key field, enter your student ID (can be found on my.grad.wisc.edu)
- b. Use the dropdowns to enter your date of birth
- c. Click "activate"
- d. Continue following the prompts by agreeing to the appropriate use guidelines, setting up a password, and choosing security questions.
- e. Then, click "activate account"
- f. For more detailed instructions, see here.
- Once you've created your NetID, it will automatically generate your <u>Wiscmail</u> account.
 - Once your account is active, you should check your Wiscmail regularly
