Josh Duggard Specifics of Case:

- Child pornography ([see trial transcripts if you want more detail](#))

Summary of Josh's Defense

- It wasn't Josh; it was another employee, Caleb Williams, who had access to the computer too and could order shipping labels and input data
 - However, Caleb Williams (through his attorney) provided law enforcement visual documentation that he was in Illinois from May 12-17 2019 when the child pornography was accessed and downloaded to the car dealership computer
 - Duggar's defense wanted documentation from law enforcement had meta data (different ways to verify digital info) to make sure Corey Williams wasn't "faking" being gone.
 - Williams had time stamped photos and a witness who took one of the photos of him in Illinois AND a live stream event of him doing a glass engraving while in Illinois
 - Defense said they had a different definition of "meta data" and those forms of verification didn't count.
 - The defense notes he knew numerous passwords on that work computer so they jump to speculate that he also knew the password for the Linux partition

Where He Stored Pornography & Hid It From Anna and Family

- His computer at the car dealership had a partitioned hard drive
 - Main operating system was Windows
 - Login password was Josh Duggar's name and the initial hint was "Josh's initial thoughts are good"
 - Small Linux partition with not a lot of storage (side with the pornography-he could delete and then pick new content/wasn't trying to keep the same stuff long term).
 - Login user was Dell_One/password Intel1988- Josh used the same username and password on his personal Macbook and other accounts he used for at least 4-5 years
 - He was using a TOR browser on the Linux partition which masks IP address (you can't trace where someone is logging in at or what they are visiting because it uses multiple locations (proxies)
 - TOR browsers also have hidden websites that use a .onion ending instead of .com and usually are just random letters/numbers- Josh had numerous hidden websites bookmarked on his TOR browser
 - One was called "Hidden Wiki" and was a TOR directory site with links to child pornography

- Evidence he downloaded webcam files from this site and opened it on his work computer (including one about a 13 year old girl in the shower)

Part Two: Joshua Generation

[Alex Harris](#) Interview

- Brother to Joshua Harris of *I Kissed Dating Goodbye* fame- his parents were very influential in the Christian homeschool movement and he has written about being part of what is termed "The Joshua Generation."
- He is a Harvard Law grad and lawyer who has denounced the emphasis of 1980s-1990s and 2000s Christian culture's obsession with taking back America for Christ but has essentially stayed conservative evangelical.
- Created a Christian teen website called [theRebelution](#) with his twin brother Bret (it's really an updated Breakaway and Brio- purity culture etc. still in-line with mainstream evangelical culture)
- He writes for the [Gospel Coalition](#), which is a group of evangelical churches in the reformed tradition.

Joshua Generation is Bigger than IBLP

- Need to consider other evangelical media outlets that share similar views to IBLP and the impact they have had on perpetuating these beliefs.
- Christian school graduates also could have been using similar materials as what homeschool Christian kids were using, so the media's definition of the Joshua Generation being only homeschoolers is very narrow.
