Get Away True North

1. Introduction and Welcome

- Emphasizes the importance of having guiding principles to stay grounded.
- Introduces the concept of principles vs. rules, both in families and organizations.

2. Core Value Highlight: We Play the Bench

- At Tab, this core value is about raising up the next generation of leaders.
- Vacation Bible School is an example of investing in emerging leaders.
- Through VBS, kids learn truths like trusting Jesus and forming their identity in Him.

3. The Need for a True North

- Life can be chaotic—what keeps us grounded?
- Jesus is our "True North," the foundation of identity for all generations.
- Jesus not only models truth and life but dies to make them accessible to us.

4. Scripture Focus: John 14:1-7

- Context: Jesus shares these words before His crucifixion, during intense emotional moments.
- Three commands in verse 1:
 - 1. Don't let your heart be troubled
 - 2. Believe in God
 - 3. Believe also in Jesus
- Emphasis on relational trust in God through belief in Jesus.

5. Jesus Prepares a Place (John 14:2-4)

- Jesus, our servant King, is preparing a place for each believer.
- Assurance that we belong and will be brought to our eternal home.
- Jesus is both the preparer and the escort to that eternal place.

6. Jesus is the Way, the Truth, and the Life (John 14:5-7)

- Thomas voices uncertainty, Jesus responds with clarity.
- Jesus uses the definite article "the" to emphasize exclusivity:
 - The way
 - o The truth
 - o The life
- Salvation isn't based on good works or performance—it's through Jesus alone.

7. The Significance of "The Way"

- Illustration: Multiple roads from North Carolina, but only one road to salvation.
- The exclusivity of Christ is not narrow-minded, it's merciful clarity.
- God's love is shown in giving a clear, singular path—Jesus.

8. Knowing the Father Through Jesus

- Jesus fully reveals the Father to us.
- If we've seen Jesus, we've seen God.
- We grow in relationship with God by obeying Scripture and yielding to the Spirit.

9. Application and Encouragement

- Children showed us this week what it looks like to pursue Jesus with joy.
- When life feels directionless, return to John 14:1-7.
- Ask God to help with unbelief (Mark 9:24).
- Promises to hold onto:
 - 1. Jesus is preparing a place for us.
 - 2. Jesus will ensure we arrive.
 - 3. Jesus is the way to truth and life.
 - 4. If we've seen Jesus, we've seen the Father.
 - 5. Jesus is our faithful North Star.

10. Invitation to Respond

- Jesus offers the gift of salvation, but we must accept it.
- No complex formula—just humility, repentance, and trust.
- Invitation for people to come forward for prayer and decision.
- Final reminder: God invites all, but there is only one way—Jesus.
